Wahoo Music Boosters Student Account Policy (adopted 2009)

- 1. Student Accounts are maintained by the Music Boosters Treasurer for Wahoo Public music students in sixth through twelfth grades.
- 2. Student Account monies may be used by the student named on the account to reduce or cover the student's responsibility for the cost of any music department sponsored event or purchase, such as music trips, music camps, uniforms, etc.
- Student Account monies may not be "cashed out", withdrawn or otherwise paid
 directly to the student or parent, except to reimburse the student or parent for
 costs they paid out-of-pocket before the end-of-year accounting of the Student
 Accounts was made.
- 4. Students earn credit in their Student Account through working at the Music Boosters Concession stand (Volunteer Credit), working at the Music Boosters Soup Supper, selling Soup Supper tickets or through any other Music Booster event or fundraiser as may be designated by the Executive Committee.
- 5. Family Volunteer Credits earned by a parent or sibling of a student with a Student Account will be assigned to the Student Account. Siblings must be at least sixth grade or older to earn family volunteer credits. If the family has more than one Student Account, the family Volunteer Credits will be evenly distributed between each family Student Account.
- 6. There will be no other provision made for earning Student Account credits, such as by friends or relatives.
- 7. Each hour of concession stand work is worth one Volunteer Credit.
- 8. The dollar value of one Volunteer Credit shall be set by the Executive Committee.
- 9. The dollar value of credit earned by students working at the Soup Supper and through selling Soup Supper tickets shall be set by the Executive Committee.
- 10. Student Account monies left in the account of a student that graduates or leaves the Wahoo Public school system will be evenly distributed into Student Accounts within the same immediate family. If there are no other Student Accounts within the same immediate family, these monies will be transferred into the Music Boosters general fund.
- 11. Student Account balances are available in a notebook designated for such purpose and located in the choir room. Balances may also be obtained at any time upon request to the Treasurer.
