## Regular Meeting Minutes School District #39

The Wahoo Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, May 18, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. via electronic means as allowed by the executive order issued by Governor Pete Ricketts. Publicized notice was given by publication in the <u>Wahoo Newspaper</u> on Wednesday, May 13th and posted on the school's website, Facebook and doors.

The meeting was held as a virtual meeting online in order to comply with the CDC's recommendation.
