## Summer School 2025 at Wahoo High School

The Wahoo Public Schools summer school program is available for students who have failed classes and would like to make up lost credit. Students who are interested need to fill out the form below and return it, along with a \$25 deposit, to the Wahoo High School office. The full amount must be paid before the start of the sessions.

The method of instruction will be through a computer program called **SchoolsPLP**. Students will be able to work at their own pace. We will run one session from 8 a.m.-12 noon, Monday through Friday, with 24 computers available. Students enrolled in the Wahoo Public Schools will have first priority. If there are open spots available, we will accept outside applications on a first-come, first-served basis. Summer School 2025 begins on Monday, June 2, and ends on Friday, June 20. Students who retrieve their credit(s) before June 20 are dismissed from summer school upon completion. A student with more than two absences will be dismissed from the program. A student with more than four tardies will be dismissed from the program (2 tardies = 1 absence.) Students will be asked to sign an attendance contract on the first day of classes.

The cost of a class this year will be \$175. A \$25 deposit must be turned in with the form below to hold a spot. Most courses will be available this summer. If you need to take a course that is not listed, please contact WHS Principal Vernon Golladay at 443-4332, Ext. 7104.

**DATES: Monday, June 2 through Friday, June 20, 2025**

**COST:** \$175 per semester class. Students may register for a second class upon completion of the first class, if time allows. A \$25 deposit will be required initially to insure a spot. **PLEASE NOTE: THE FULL AMOUNT MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE START OF THE FIRST SESSION.**

**TIME:** 8 a.m.-Noon. **Students must report at 8 a.m. and stay until noon.**

**GRADE:** Students will receive a "P" for passing based on a 70% or better completion of assignments and quizzes/tests, and projects. Students will receive an "F" for failing if the completion average is 69% or below.
