The Fremont Area Car Club is pleased to inform you of a college scholarship that we are making available this year. This scholarship will be for the amount of \$1,000.00 and will be available to current graduating seniors meeting the following guidelines:

- Student needs to have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25.
- Student needs to attend an accredited trade school or community college.
- Student needs to be enrolled in a course of study directly related to the automotive industry. This may include (but not limited to) automotive technology, body and collision repair, classic car restoration and/or fabrication.

The scholarship will be disbursed in two increments: \$500.00 at the beginning of both the first and second terms. Upon earning the scholarship, we request a short letter (essay) on the student's progress, goals, and course of study along with visiting one of our meetings. Our club meets on the first Thursday of every month at 7PM.

To apply, the student will need to complete the attached Scholarship Application. The application, along with the required documents listed above, will need to be submitted to the address shown on the form no later than May 1, 2024. Winners of the scholarship will be informed in May. The applicant will be asked to provide proof of enrollment, and the disbursement will be made directly to their college.
