JEO Scholarship

\$500 per year

Eligibility:

- 1. A graduating senior from Wahoo High School with application for enrollment in either a 4-year or 2-year accredited school and planning to study in one of the following areas: Civil, Sanitary or Electrical Engineering; Architecture, Surveying; Planning; or associated CAD (Computer Aided Drafting).
- 2. ACT scores reported to Wahoo High School.

Guidelines:

- 1. Complete sections 1 and 3 of the application
- 2. Request your counselor to complete section 2
- 3. Request 3 letters of recommendation. One must be from a faculty member of Wahoo High School and the other two should be either a current/former employer or a community member not related to the applicant.
- 4. Must be enrolled as a full time student (minimum of 12 credit hours if in college) each semester and maintain a 2.0 grade point average in the classes that relate to the major area of study.
- 5. Upon completion of each semester the applicant must turn his/her grades into Wahoo High School in order to receive his/her check for that semester. The applicant must continue his/her study in one of the areas listed above in order to continue to be eligible for the scholarship.
- 6. This scholarship is worth \$500 per year (\$250 per semester) and is renewable for up to four years as long as the student meets the requirements listed above.
- 7. Return the completed application with letters of recommendation to **JEO by APRIL 1st**. A resume can also be submitted in addition to but not as a replacement of this application form.
