Dear Applicant,

Detachment 1275 of the Fremont Area Marine Corps League will award two, \$1,000 scholarships to members of the Class of 2025 in its area high schools. The two scholarships are competitive and open to **all Seniors** at the eligible schools. The eligible high schools are: Fremont High, Archbishop Bergan High, North Bend Central High, Cedar Bluffs High, Logan View High, Arlington High, Wahoo High, Bishop Neumann High, and Missouri Valley High. There is **NO** required commitment to the Marine Corps or to be the descendant of a veteran. The scholarship competition is open to all Seniors in eligible schools.

Seniors who plan to attend a four-year or two-year college or vocational school are eligible. Criteria for selection include academic achievement as documented by GPA, ACT/SAT scores, and evidence of advanced coursework; high school and community activity participation; community service activities; character and exemplary personal qualities as documented by one **letter of recommendation**, and completion of a brief personal essay.

Application forms in Word format are available from your Counselor and are due back to the Counselor by the end of the school day on **Monday, March 3, 2025**.

The Detachment's selection committee will review the applications and notify Guidance Counselors of the winners sometime after Monday, Mar. 24. The scholarships will be payable in January 2026, upon demonstration of successful completion of the first semester of post-secondary school. Scholarship winners will receive a letter from me explaining these procedures.

I want to stress that the Fremont Area Marine Corps League is a veterans' organization, not an official part of the Marine Corps, and no commitment to service or relationship to a veteran is required of applicants. The scholarship is open to **ALL Seniors**. Further information on the scholarships can be obtained from me at the address below.
