### MILRAE ANDERSON MUSIC EDUCATOR SCHOLARSHIP

(\$500 each semester/quarters, renewable up to 8 semesters/quarters)

A scholarship, in the amount of \$500 per semester, will be provided by Milrae Anderson. The Scholarship will be presented annually to a senior of Wahoo High School who plans to pursue a major in Music Education.

## **Selection Criteria & Process:**

- 1. A graduating senior from Wahoo High School with application for enrollment completed, and confirmation of acceptance received from the school s/he plans to attend in the upcoming fall; planning to pursue 4-year degree program of study in Music Education. The major can be either Instrumental Music or Vocal Music Education. Students have the option of attending a 2-year college with the intent of transferring to a 4-year college to complete a bachelor's degree in Music Education.
- 2. A senior pursuing a degree in Elementary Music Education (K-6) will be given priority in the selection process.
- 3. If no senior is pursuing a degree in Elementary Music Education (K-6), the secondary priority will be to select a senior applying for 7-12 or 9-12 Music Education.
- 3. Candidates must have attended Wahoo Public High School at least one full school year.
- 4. Candidates must have participated in either an Instrumental or Vocal courses for at least one year in high school
- 4. Letter of recommendation from either Instrumental or Vocal teacher.
- 5. Letter of recommendation from a community member not related to the applicant.
- 6. Other supporting documentation or letters of recommendation from music-sponsored activities would be welcomed in the selection process (e.g. church, college honors music programs, etc.)
- 7. The first year the scholarship is offered the deadline will be: May 6, 2013. Thereafter, the deadline will be: March 1st.
- 8. The WHS Scholarship Committee will review and select the winner.

## **Application Process:**

- 1. Complete Sections 1 and 3 of the Application.
- 2. Request Wahoo High School Counselor complete Section 2
- 3. Request Letter of Recommendation from
  - a. A music teacher of Wahoo High School
  - b. A community member not related to the applicant.
- 4. Show proof of enrollment as a full-time student, and acceptance in an accredited Music Education program at an accredited college *in Nebraska* during the fall semester following graduation.
- 5. Return completed WHS Application with Letters of Recommendation to the Counselor's office by the deadline.

## Terms and Conditions for Receipt of the Award and Renewal of the Scholarship:

- 1. The recipient is responsible to provide the college's financial aid & scholarship office's correct mailing address to Wahoo Public School Superintendent's Office and the following prior to receiving any scholarship monies.
- 2. The recipient must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 at an accredited institution the student has chosen to attend
- 3. Provide proof of enrollment as a full-time student in an accredited Music Education program at an accredited college <u>following graduation no later than August 15<sup>th</sup></u>, to the Wahoo High School Counselor, then \$500 will be sent to the college's financial aid and scholarship office for fall tuition costs for the recipient.
- 4. Thereafter, at the end of each subsequent semester, the recipient will provide an official college transcript with proof of continued full-time enrollment in Music Education with a minimum Grade Point Average of a 2.0 in order to renew the \$500 scholarship until a total of seven semesters has been completed. The \$500 will be applied to tuition cost for the recipients, with the finances handled by Wahoo Public Schools Superintendent's Office.
- 5. If the student fails to adhere to the conditions or this process, s/he will no longer be eligible for these funds.
