STEM CONNECT **SCHOLARSHIP**



**Scholarships valued at up to \$8,000
per year for up to four years**

The STEM CONNECT Scholarship program welcomes applications from students who will be first year or second year students in Fall 2021. Funded by the National Science Foundation, these scholarships seek to attract and support academically talented, low-income students with interest in careers that require strong skills in mathematics or computer science.

Eligible Community Colleges

Students who apply to Southeast Community College or Western Nebraska Community College must:

- enroll in the Academic Transfer program
- have strong interest in careers that require strengths in mathematics or computer science

Some scholarships are available to students already at Nebraska, SCC, and WNCC.

When to Apply

The application period begins Feb. 15. First review of applications will begin March 15 for all applications received by that date, with a final deadline of May 1.

Need-Based

STEM CONNECT is a need-based federal scholarship program. To be considered for a STEM CONNECT scholarship, your family must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). www.fafsa.ed.gov

How to Apply

- If not currently a student, first apply to your institution of choice (SCC or WNCC).
- Complete the Fall 2021 scholarship application in the CSMCE Application/Registration Portal at <https://go.unl.edu/scimathapply>.
- Applicants who have not submitted the FAFSA are encouraged to do so as soon as possible.

Award

Depending on financial need, up to \$8,000 per year for up to two years at SCC or WNCC and then additional two years after transfer to UNL.

- Note: SCC students interested in Health (nursing, medicine) are not eligible.
