(\$1000; Non-renewable)

- Maintains a 3.5 GPA or greater
- Participates in at least one year of Wahoo High School cross-country or track (must run middle or long distance)
- Demonstrates a strong commitment to school or community volunteerism

Application must include a current transcript, a current résumé and a completed question/answer document (next page).

Application Deadline: March 1st of graduating year
