Bethlehem – Luther Heritage Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. To qualify, the graduating senior needs to be a member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church (BLC) for at least two years.
- 2. The graduating senior attends and has been active in the church.
- 3. The graduating senior has been accepted and will attend and ELCA (Evangelical Lutheran Church in America) college or university.
- 4. The scholarship amount will depend on the earnings of the invested principal in the Scholarship Fund. Only earnings will be available to be awarded in the scholarship.
- 5. The scholarship funds available will be divided equally between eligible recipients.
- 6. The maximum scholarship award will be \$1000.
- 7. The maximum award will be reviewed by the scholarship committee as the fund amount increases in future years.
- 8. The goal is to award scholarships to students for their 2^{nd} through 4^{th} years as the fund grows and as money is available. Priority for this scholarship is for 1^{st} year students.
- 9. Completed applications should be returned to the Bethlehem Lutheran Church office no later than April 1.
