The October meeting of the Wahoo Music Boosters was called to order by President Lana Robinson. Lana followed the opening by stating the mission of the Music Boosters organization Mission Statement.

The Treasurer report was given by Steven Olson in Angela's absence and Secretary report from Kelli Mattson were given. Steve Olson made a motion to approve the minutes and was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Di Pfeiffer.

Mr. Smith shared updates from the band department including:

- Thank you to the Boosters and parents for all of their help during the marching season
- Nov. 7<sup>th</sup> – Fall Band Concert
- Nov. 13<sup>th</sup> – Veteran's Program
- Sydney Haldsworth made it into All-State band and will be auditioning for chair placement
- 6 out of 8 seniors will be auditioning for collegiate music programs
- Wahoo Music Department will be receiving an award at NMEC for having 40% of all WHS students participating in music.

- 1<sup>st</sup> payment for Kansas City trip are due Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>
- Chocolate sales will begin next month. They will arrive Nov. 20<sup>th</sup> or 27<sup>th</sup>.
- Mr. Smith requested a parent assistant for Chocolate Sales to help receive and count money.
- A request to purchase a \$200 quad stand was made. Stacey Barnes made a motion for said purchase. Stephanie Taylor 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and was approved all.
- Additional uniforms have been requested.
- Stacey Barnes brought up getting different drum major uniforms that are more up-to-date as to what other schools have.

Mr. Boe shared updates from the choral department including:

- Nov. 7<sup>th</sup> Conference Choral Clinic will be held at Plattview with a concert at 6:00
- Nov. 13<sup>th</sup> will be the Pathfinder Fundraising Concert at 8:00. Choir will perform
- Dec. 14<sup>th</sup> will be the Choral Christmas Concert
- Jan 21<sup>st</sup> is the date set for the Big Red Singers Fundraising Concert
- Jan. 2<sup>nd</sup> and Jan. 29<sup>th</sup> Parent/volunteer meetings will be held for COC
- Mr. Boe announced that Isaac Redding made the American Choral Directors Regional Honor Choir. Isaac will fill out a scholarship application to help fund this trip.

Mrs. Smith (elementary music) shared that the Kdg./1<sup>st</sup> Christmas program will be held Nov. 28 at 7:00. They will be performing "Toys".

#### Old Business

Mr. Boe cleared up a miscommunication about the purchase of 2 keyboards and 2 cases. A purchase request was made to the school for 2 keyboards and 2 cases for the music department. \$2117.62 was the purchase price for each. When approved by the school, it was thought by Mr. Boe and Mr. Smith that the school was paying for both (\$4235.24 total). However, there was \$2117.62 that was transferred from the Booster account to the school. The school agreed to pay for

one of the keyboards with the Music Boosters paying for the other. This had not been approved before the transaction occurred. However, Music Booster agreed to approve the purchase of the 2<sup>nd</sup> keyboard. Di Pfifer made the motion, Brian Elder 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and all approved.

Other unfinished business included the collegiate board and trophy case for the music department. Neither are here yet, however Mr. Kaminski is working on it.
