PRINCIPAL'S PAGES School motivation for students





Why is student motivation lacking this time of the school year? Does your child lack motivation?

It can happen at any point of the school year to any student, but seems to happen more often in the months of February and March. It's a common, but serious source of worry for teachers and parents: You start to notice a lack of motivation and commitment in student's attitude and effort towards school.

Parents: How can you help get your child motivated? There are many potential reasons that a student might be turned off by school. The following are some steps that you can take to investigate what might be happening:

- > Define your concerns clearly to your child.
- *If they are bored, ask what they mean?* Sometimes kids who are being challenged or frustrated about school aren't sure what to call that feeling.
- *Communicate to the school and/or teacher.* We are the best resource that you can use to both help identify the issues and then find ways to address them.
- Clarify your expectations.
- *Is it a part of the learning process?* It's normal for a child to not be 'motivated' because they are learning new material and it's not easy.

The Wahoo Middle School Staff are going to give every effort, and use every strategy to try and make sure ALL students are highly motivated and engaged for the remainder of the school year. If you are struggling with your child's motivation, or think there may be an issue with academics because of motivation please contact us; we are a team and want to make your son or daughter's experiences at school both productive and meaningful.
